PUBLICATION OF THE NATIONAL HAND HYGIENE NHS CAMPAIGN COMPLIANCE WITH HAND HYGIENE – AUDIT REPORT

Please find attached the National Hand Hygiene NHS Campaign Compliance with Hand Hygiene – Audit Report. **This report must be regarded as confidential and embargoed until the publication date of 13th March 2009.**

The report contains results by NHS Boards and by staff groups and you can review the results of your own Board on page 16.

The overall result for hand hygiene compliance for this 4th Quarter audit period 2009 was 93% (14th to 27th January 2009). Compliance percentages within NHS Boards ranged from 89% to 98%. Overall results for compliance with hand hygiene opportunities between staff groups ranged from 85%-95%.
